Five sessions will be run over the weekend, including a presentation ceremony. Each session will consist of 3-4 plays followed by a short break. This may change depending on the number of entries.

Tickets will be available to purchase for individual sessions and a weekend Festival pass will be available at a discounted price.

Port Macquarie One Act Play Festival

Conditions of Entry

- All directors, actors and crew must be of amateur status*
- Groups may enter up to two plays
- Plays can be a drama, a comedy or farce
- Plays require a minimum of two performers with dialogue**
- Each entry must be on an official entry form
- The Adjudicator's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into

Entry Fee

- Entry fee is **\$50** per play
- Fees must be received by the Festival Coordinator before each entry is acknowledged
- The following <u>must be sent</u> with the entry form:
 - o Cast lists
 - o Synopsis of the play (max. 100 words)
 - o A short history of the theatre group
 - o A digital script (or 2 clean hard copies)
 - o Proof of Royalty payments (if applicable)
 - o Any special requests
 - o Legal forms (if applicable)

Closing Date

• <u>Deadline</u> for entries is Friday 11th April 2025

The Play

- Length At least 20 minutes in duration
- Groups are allocated a <u>maximum of 60 minutes per production</u> (including time to set and strike stage)[^]
- Staging Groups are responsible for setting and striking their stage
- Groups may provide their own backstage crew who will work in conjunction with the Festival Stage Manager
- <u>Requests for additional assistance</u> must be received in writing prior to the technical rehearsals
- Lighting plots and special effects will require special arrangements with the Festival
- Technical Coordinator and must be requested in writing with your scripts.

Rehearsals

- There will be **NO** onstage rehearsals, including local groups.
- There will only be technical rehearsals for props, sound and lighting
- Times for technical rehearsals will be strictly adhered to.
- Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to your allocated time.



Theatre Information

- Please refer to the separate document for stage dimensions
- The seating capacity of the theatre is 222
- In house audio equipment is available and will be operated from the Sound and Lighting Box by the Festival Sound and Lighting Technicians
- The Festival Stage Manager will be available for help and advice wherever necessary
- The Players Theatre cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to participants' property during the festival.

Other important information

- If your play requires the use of a <u>gun or sword</u> of any description, including imitation, the name of the person responsible must be specified with your scripts
- Copies of any legal forms must be attached to entries
- Prior notice in writing MUST accompany your scripts if you intend to shoot blanks
- If too many entries are received, the decision on who performs rests solely with the Festival Committee and no correspondence will be entered into
- The Festival Committee may request a second choice from groups who submit the same play
- The Festival Committee reserves the right to allot dates and times as demanded by the needs of the program and other competitors
- <u>Short notice alterations</u> to the program may have to be made if groups are late or do not appear

Further explanations:

- * That is, their role in theatre, film or television is not their major source of income.
- ** Monologues or mime will not be considered.
- ^ Plays may be penalised if they extend beyond these boundaries

Furniture, Props and Special Requirements

- The Players Theatre stage is 9.3m at the curtain line with 5m behind the line & a forestage of up to 2m deep.
- There are two black leg flats which can be travelled to any position across the stage plus front & rear tabs.
- Access to the back of the stage area is via a loading dock, at truck height, with easy access directly onto the stage.
- The theatre has lights and sound facilities of a professional standard, good size appointed dressing rooms, and a large foyer with bar and refreshment facilities. All facilities are air conditioned.
- Hand props are your responsibility.
- Players will provide some large props, (within reason) such as, sofa, bed, table, chairs, dresser, and will endeavour to assist with other reasonable requests.

• *Please note storage space is minimal. Groups are not to touch, move, interfere or borrow props for other plays.


